#### 2. Approval of the agenda

The agenda is approved with no comments or modifications.

Mr. Mati Sarevet, ELDFA, requests to take the floor in the AOB section to inform about the work of the EU Working Group on Decarbonisation and Energy Transition Partnership for the Distant Water Fleet and table a proposal to collaborate with it.

#### 3. Adoption of the minutes of the Executive Committee (Brussels, March 2025)

The minutes of the previous Executive Committee meeting held on 13 March 2025 in Brussels are approved without any comments or changes.



## 4. Overview of LDAC work in Y18 and request for adoption of pending LDAC working papers and advice

The General Secretary, Mr. Alexandre Rodríguez, informs that the following final advice drafts to be presented for approval have been previously distributed via email among ExCom members.

- Advice on regional management of small pelagic stocks in West Africa (WG4): the proponent, Ms. Béatrice Gorez, CFFA-CAPE, summarises the content of the draft document, which is unanimously approved by the Executive Committee.

ACTION: Approved document to be sent to DG MARE and to be brought to the attention of EFCA, ATLAFCO-COMHAFAT and AFRIFISH-Net.

- Advice on improving transparency of fishing joint ventures in third countries (WG4/WG5): Ms. Manuela Iglesias, LDAC coordinator, explains the content of the document, noting that some final modifications have been received.

ACTION: Distribute for the last time the final draft among all Executive Committee members for approval granting a period of 8 calendar days. In the event that no modifications are received, it will be submitted to the EC.

- LDAC Position paper in reply to EU public consultation on CFP evaluation: Mr. Alexandre Rodríguez, General Secretary, explains that it is a summary report prepared by the Secretariat to address the EU public consultation before the deadline, in line with previous pieces of advice on this matter. It intends to be a document informing on work process and future actions in terms of CFP internal dimension and foreign policy that the LDAC will provide in the months to come. It is unanimously approved.

ACTION: The Secretary will upload the document onto the Commission's public consultation website and will email a copy to the AC coordination team at DG MARE.

- 5. Update on the work of Working Groups:

Ms. Anne-France Mattlet, WG1 Chair, Mr. Emil Remisz, WG2 Chair, Ms. Béatrice Gorez, WG4 Chair and Mr. Julien Daudu, WG5 Chair, summarise in turn what happened in the latest meetings of the WG they each represent and then share the topics to be addressed in the months to come. The list of agreed actions is available in the relevant WG minutes.

Following the summary, the Chair, Mr. Iván López, suggests considering the possibility of involving further the Director on international fisheries at MARE.B by inviting him to participate in the LDAC Executive Committee meetings and encouraging him to have a continuous and fluent informal dialogue with this AC.



#### 6. Election procedure for the Executive Committee

#### • Description of the election procedure by the Secretariat

The General Secretary, Mr. Alexandre Rodríguez, explains that on 1 June 2025, the LDAC will start its year 19 of operation since it was created. Since positions have a 3-year term of office ending on 31 May 2025, it will be necessary to hold a new election. Therefore, at the annual regular meeting of the LDAC General Assembly that will take place afterwards, the election for the positions of LDAC Chair and Vice Chairs and for the Executive Committee members will be held.

The Secretary informs that at the beginning of the year an election call was launched in accordance with the LDAC regulatory requirements, granting extended periods for the submission of expressions of interest by any LDAC interested member organisation. Member organisations sent their expressions of interest to be part of the Executive Committee by 5 May, and so did members interested in running for the positions of Chair and Vice Chairs.

The election procedure that was previously distributed in writing is now outlined:

- The members of the General Assembly have the power to appoint the Chair, the Vice Chairs and the members of the Executive Committee.
- Any organisation that is a member of the GA is entitled to submit its expression of interest to be member of the ExCom, provided that they have no outstanding payments and that they have not been subject to disciplinary measures or sanctions.
- The current members of the Executive Committee may be re-elected, and no mandatory maximum mandate period is set for them.
