






landing obligation

landing obligation in the Atlantic

scope

catches under TAC
 (international obligations)
 (additional species)

phasing in (all fisheries in 2019)

- 2015: pelagic & industrial fisheries
- 2016-2019: demersal fisheries

quota flexibility

- max 9 % interspecies quota use
- max 10 % interannual banking/borrowing



landing obligation

exemptions

surviving species (scientific evidence) de minimis (< 7 %) (selectivity, handling costs)

minimum conservation reference sizes (not for direct human consumption)

documentation (inter alia observers, CCTV, others)

multiannual plans for implementation details: discard plan when no multiannual plan (regionalization):

COM act on de minimis (up to 5 %) when no plan





setting the rules straight - 1



landing obligation



"omnibus"

amends 5 technical and the control regulation

rules on catch composition rules on by-catch (in special areas) minimum landing sizes control rules

recording/stowage/notification of catches (separate undersized fish); fishing authorization; standards for remote electronic recording; serious infringement







landing obligation

setting the rules straight - 2

outcome "omnibus"

- removal catch composition & by-catch rules
- minimum conservation reference sizes (mls out)
- technical (selectivity) measures in discard plans
- continued 10 % derogation some pelagic species
- synchronization mcrs and minimum marketing size
- return predator-damaged fish to the sea
- MS and POs role for landed undersized fish
- stowage/recording (separate for undersized, not by species), over 50 kg
- delay of serious infringement (2017)

adoption process (Council, European Parliament)
May: expected publication

some challenges

process:

- timely delivery of joint recommendations by MS groups
- timely delivery of advice by STECF
- timely adoption and approval by Council & Parliament

landing obligation

substance:

- clarity of rules (Omnibus)
- choices for phasing in understandable?
- implementation elements clear (definition of de minimis percentages, interspecies quota flexibility (9%)
- adjustments of TACs (to change from landings to catch quotas)
- · adjustment of swapping
- avoiding choke species in absence of multiannual plans

daily management

- adjustment of fishing practice to new conditions
- compliance and control of the new obligations
